



Developing a Self-Determined Student

Participants will learn some of the components of Self-Determination which will include self-awareness, self-direction, self-regulation and self-advocacy. Participants will also increase knowledge of instructional practices to support self-determination, as well as understand the need for individual student empowerment.

The afternoon session will consist of the need for students to take an active role in the planning of their IEP, and more importantly, their transition goals and post-secondary goals. Participants will also have the opportunity to review various materials used for Self-Determination. New trends concerning transition plans will be discussed.
